Similarities	Differences
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must appear to be an upstanding citizen ▪ Male dominated ▪ Monarch still sits at the top ▪ Still have a governor general represent the monarch within Canada ▪ Prime Minister and representatives from different parts of the country meet ▪ Division of power (central government for the entire country & separate government for the provinces) ▪ Must be well off (have to be able to afford education, campaign etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Women can hold positions ▪ More multicultural (people of backgrounds other than British can hold positions) ▪ More roles & responsibilities in the system ▪ The French have their own political party (were not even allowed to hold a position in parliament at Confederation) ▪ The age limit is younger (use to have to be over the age of 30)
